**POWER BOAT AND PWC REGISTRATION SCHEME**

We continue to operate a reciprocal agreement with the three surrounding local authorities, Gwynedd, Anglesey and Conwy. Unfortunately, Gwynedd Council have not been able to confirm that they are willing to maintain the reciprocal agreement for this season. However, we will continue to accept their registration scheme, as the primary objective is vessel identification.

**MOORINGS**

Occupancy is near to 100% throughout the Harbour limits, excluding Block A in Port Dinorwic. This is the 15 moorings that were sublet to Port Dinorwic mariner. So far, we have allocated 4 out of the 15. I anticipate demand to increase during this month.

**SEIONT IV**

The vessel is afloat and ready for service. The vessel has now almost been fully repainted. When a favourable opportunity arises the vessel will be taken to port Penrhyn to the drying grid to finish the antifouling.

**Y FORYD**

The vessel has been utilised over the last few weekends to undertake patrol duties given the exceptional weather and the traffic density encountered due to additional bank holidays.
